Wine Club Prepares for Big Show.

The Committee for the Victorian Wine Show at their meeting last Tuesday were busy in the final planning for this years wine show. The show is scheduled to be held from Wednesday, October 22nd to Saturday 25th. The judging will be held at the Broadford Leisure Centre on the Wednesday to the Friday with the awards being presented at a dinner at the Mitchelton Winery on Friday 24th.

The Wine show is in its 28th year and the organising committee was established as part of the Seymour Agricultural and Pastoral Society but later became a stand alone organisation.

Entrants are restricted to wines grown and made in Victoria. Last year there were over 1300 wines submitted and indications are that similar numbers should be expected this year. The judging will be done by a panel of 20 experts from all over Australia. Although smaller, Victoria has more wine growers than any other State.
